

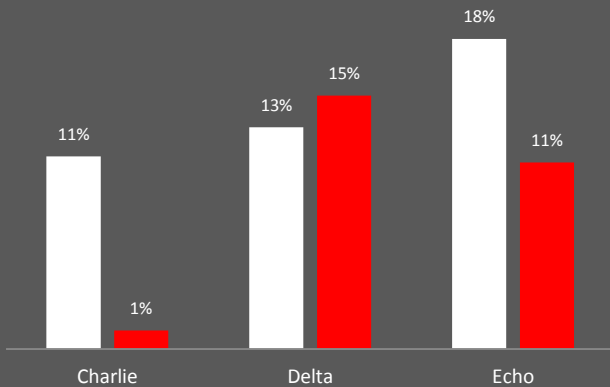
Orientation at AMANTECH held – Students familiarized with Institute and Instructors

- Total Service Calls provided during the week were 50 and total handling time inclusive of all service levels were 9 minutes and 38 seconds.

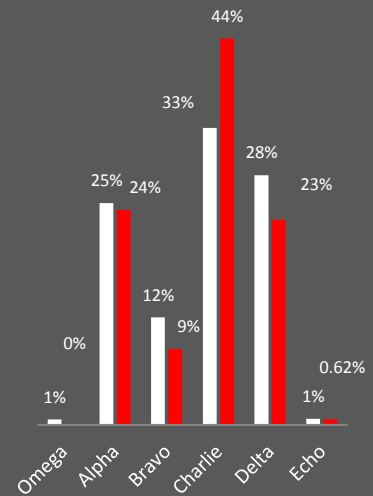
■ Average Response Time > 10 min ■ w103



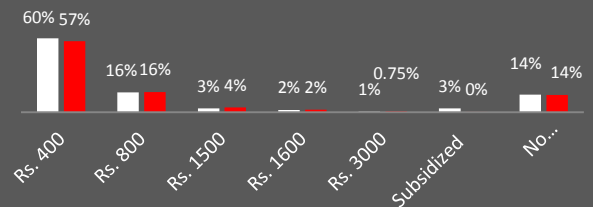
EMS

- Total interventions of 1462, meant an increase of 5 percent from last week.
- Life threatening cases handled were 24 percent.
- Serious cases handled were 52 percent, totaling an A and B case load of 76 percent.
- A total of 9 Echo calls were handled, out of which 1 was delayed.
- Average response time was 7.7 minutes per intervention.
