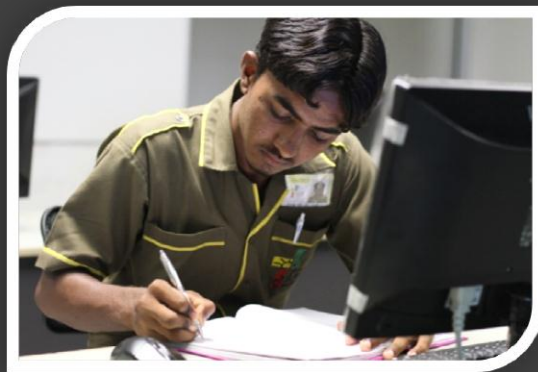


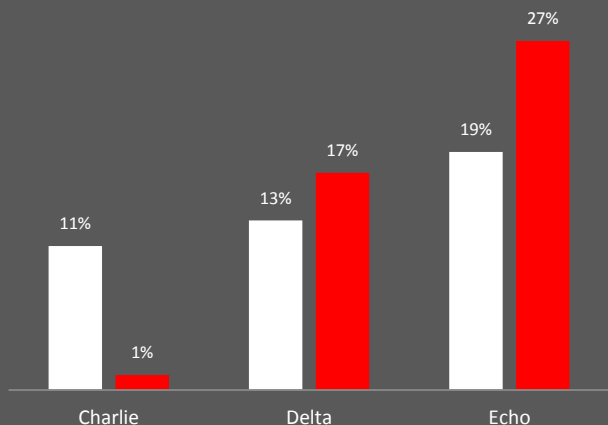
## AMANTECH – New Session commences this week



### HEALTH PROJECTS

- Aman Community Health Initiative ACHI is currently forming new community based organizations. Identification of more Paaras will begin next week. Six paaras with 1297 households have been mapped thus far.
- Total Service Calls provided during the week were 164 and total handling time inclusive of all service levels were 10 minutes and 06 seconds.
- Marketing collateral for AMANTELEHEALTH have been printed and are ready for the launch on 31 December 2011.

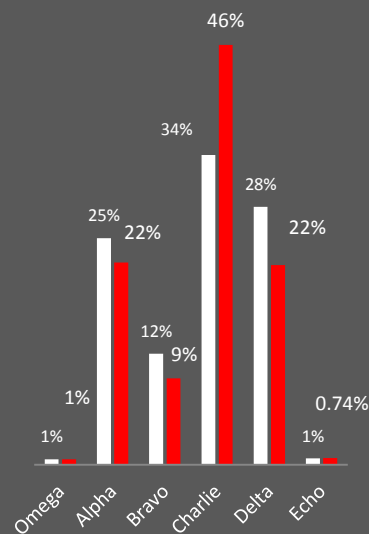
■ Average Response Time > 10 min ■ w104



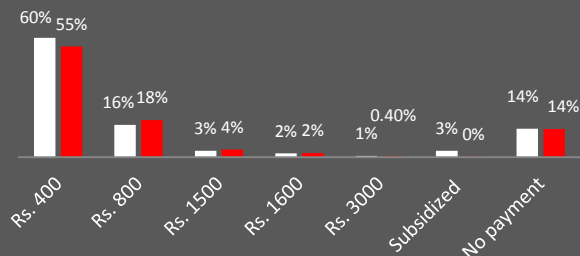
### EMS

- Total interventions of 1493, meant an increase of 2 percent from last week.
- Life threatening cases handled were 22 percent.
- Serious cases handled were 55 percent, totaling an A and B case load of 77 percent.
- A total of 11 Echo calls were handled, out of which 3 were delayed.
- Average response time was 7.7 minutes per intervention.
