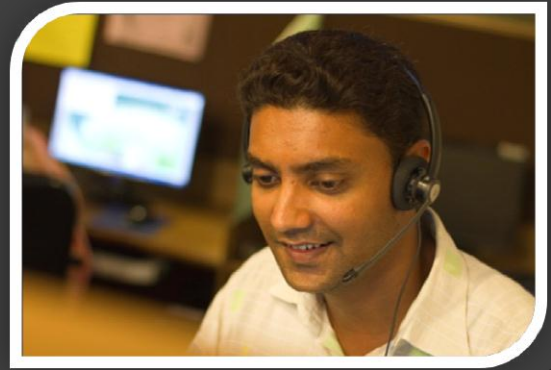


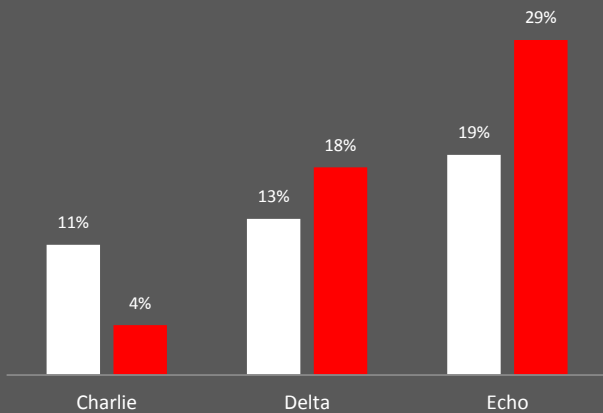
## AMANTELEHEALTH launched this week



### HEALTH PROJECTS

- AMANTELEHEALTH Service was launched this week. Attended by various NGOs and social sector representatives, the event commenced with an introduction to the Aman Foundation by the CEO, Mr Ahsan Jamil, followed by a presentation by Executive Director Aman Healthcare Services, Dr Junaid Razzak and, Head of Telehealth, Dr Faheem Sheikh.
- Total Service Calls provided during the week were 106 and total handling time inclusive of all service levels were 11 minutes and 56 seconds.
- The mapping exercise of selected areas in Ibrahim Hyderi continues. Till-date 15 paara's (mohallas) with 3294 houses have been mapped, followed by the formation of new CBOS.

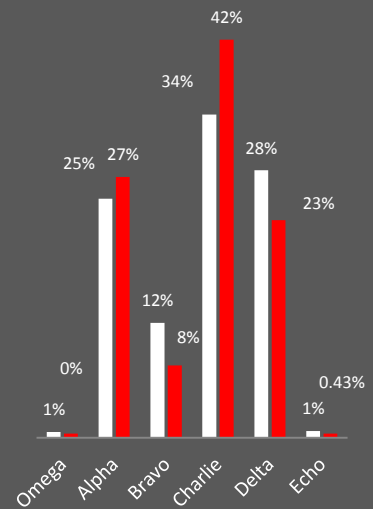
■ Average Response Time > 10 min ■ w105



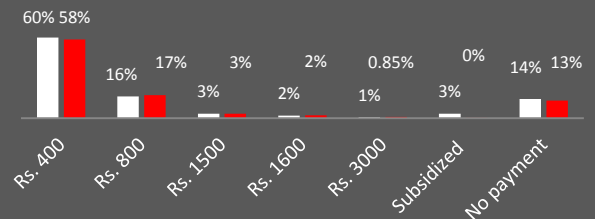
### EMS

- Total interventions of 1640, meant an increase of 10 percent from last week.
- Life threatening cases handled were 23 percent.
- Serious cases handled were 49 percent, totaling an A and B case load of 72 percent.
- A total of 7 Echo calls were handled, out of which 2 were delayed.
- Average response time was 8.3 minutes per intervention.
