

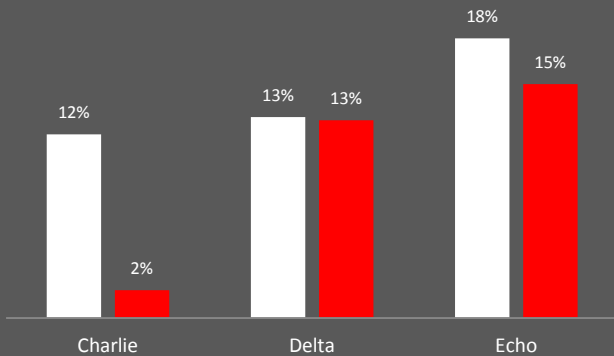
City & Guilds Examinations to be conducted next week



HEALTH PROJECTS

- Information for 933 healthcare facilities have been added to the Health Directory Database. Entries for Korangi, Jamshed, Landhi, Bin-Qasim, Malir, DHA, Shah Faisal and Clifton) have been completed successfully. However data entry for Saddar, North Nazimabad and Gulshan towns are still in progress.
- Total Service Calls provided during the week were 69 and total handling time inclusive of all service levels were **13 minutes** and **37 seconds**.

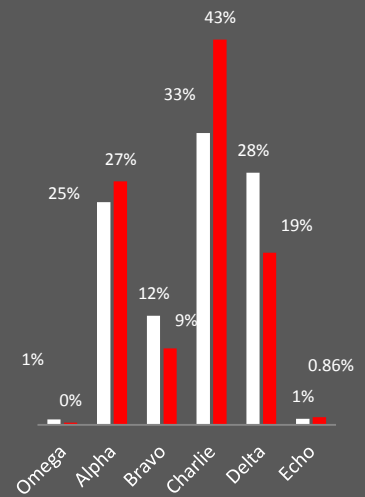
■ Average Response Time > 10 min ■ w100



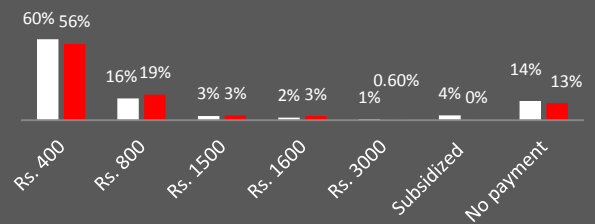
EMS

- Total interventions of 1506 meant a 15 per cent increase from last week.
- Life threatening cases handled were 20 percent.
- Serious cases handled were 52 percent, totaling an A and B case load of 72 percent.
- A total of 13 Echo calls were handled, out of which 2 were delayed.
- Average response time was 7.7 minutes per intervention.
